Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the facts of the present case is identical to the case of C.W.J.C. No. 12728 of 2012 (Manoj Kumar Singh Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.), the aforesaid order squarely covers the issue involved in the present case.
