ORAL ORDER

3 09-05-2018 Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Nabinagar P.S.Case nO.61 of 2018 , registered for offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 379 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he is owner of Nabinagar Pianeo Agency of the Tempo and the informant has purchased Tempo from his agency and he used to pay installment to him but the informant never deposited installment to the bank and later on also snatched the tempo from him.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the whole allegation is false and concocted and Rs.31,000/- and odd is due with the informant and he has not taken possession of the tempo and a false and concocted case has been lodged.



Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Aurangabad (Bihar) in connection with Nabinagar P.S.Case no.61 of 2018 , subject to condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

With following conditions :

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned court.
- (ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- (iii) The petitioner shall co-operate in the investigation of the case and make himself available as and when required by the Police, otherwise, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bond.

With the aforesaid direction, this application is allowed.
