Considering the aforesaid, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Gaya to verify the relevant record and if it is found that the petitioner has worked for the aforesaid period of two months and there is no infirmity in the appointment of the petitioner, District Programme Officer (Establishment), Gaya shall ensure payment of salary for the aforesaid period within a



maximum period of four months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order failing which the arrears will carry interest at the rate of 9% per annum.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
