It appears from Annexure 7 to the contempt application itself that as per the direction of this Court, the



Director, Higher Education, Government of Bihar, Patna has to get an enquiry made and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law. The same has already been done by the Director.

So far as other grievances are concerned, no case for contempt is made out.

The application thus stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to raise their grievances before the University, if at all tenable under law.
