It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the writ petition has become infructuous since the programme under which the appointment of respondent no. 7 was made during petitioner's continuation as Programme Coordinator in Literacy India Mission, 2012 has come to an end in the year 2016. He submits that the only issue which remains is regarding payment of honorarium to the petitioner as he has continued to discharge his duties till 30.04.2013. He seeks liberty to raise his claim before the respondent no. 4.

Without expressing any opinion on the claim made by the



petitioner, this Court would observe that the claim of the petitioner has to be considered and disposed off by a reasoned and speaking order by the respondent authorities and any admissible dues if found, shall be paid to the petitioner within a period of six months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

Writ petition is disposed off.
