2 In view of the scheme for grant of ex gratia (lump sum amount) in lieu of appointment on compassionate appointment having come into force with effect from 31.07.2006, claim of the petitioner for compassionate appointment in light of death of his father in harness on 10.04.2009 is not enforceable since there was no such scheme for compassionate appointment as on the date the father of the petitioner died in harness in service of the respondent-Bank.



3 The policy having been brought on record by Annexure A to the counter affidavit, no rejoinder has been filed inasmuch as the said position has not been disputed by the petitioner, no relief can be granted to the writ petitioner.

4 The writ petition is dismissed.
