ORAL ORDER

3 21-06-2018 The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Alauli P.S. Case No. 63 of 2016, registered for offences punishable under Sections 302, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner no. 1 is the father of the deceased and petitioner no. 2 is the husband and the allegation against them is of causing death of the deceased.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the deceased died due to her illness and she was under treatment and the F.I.R itself shows that the time of cremation of the deceased, the people from *Sasural* side as well as *naihar* side were present. Further the statement of mother in para -53 of the case diary also



shows that she was ill and under treatment.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, in view of the above facts, let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 25,000 (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria, in connection with Alauli P.S. Case No. 63 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C, as well as subject to the following conditions, it is further subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- (ii) The petitioners shall cooperate in the investigation and make themselves available as and when required by the police and on the event of failure on their part to appear before the police on two consecutive dates



without showing any genuine reasons, the prosecution is free to move for cancellation of their bail bonds.
