The present writ petition has been filed for quashing of the demand notice issued by the S.D.O., Narkatiyaganj (Respondent no. 4) vide memo no.244 dated 08.04.2015 for realization of amount on the charges of negligence, misappropriation and embezzlement of



Government fund; and for connected reliefs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the light of the order dated 18.11.2011 passed in CWJC No. 17532 of 2011 (Annexure-1), the petitioner has since deposited 20% of the value of undistributed rice and for which receipts have been issued(Annexure-3 series). It is therefore, submitted that the said order of this Court stands complied with.
