After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to file objection before the Certificate Officer, Munger and further seeks that in the meantime, no coercive action may be taken against the petitioner.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file objection under Section 9 of the Bihar & Orissa Public Demand Recovery Act within a period of eight weeks from today, whereafter the Certificate Officer shall consider the same on merits and pass a final order.

Till passing of the final order, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner herein.
