3 12-12-2018 Heard counsel for the petitioner and counsel
appearing on behalf of the opposite parties.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case No. 390 of 2017 for offences under Sections 409, 201 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the fact that there is allegation of defalcation of a sum of Rs. 2,596/- against the petitioner only and the petitioner is still working in the Bihar State Road Gtransport Corporation but no departmental proceeding has been initiated against him, the Court is inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within four



weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mohammad Javed Ahmad Khan, Sub-Judge-VI-cum- ACJM, Patna in connection with Gandhi Maidan P.S. Case No. 390 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.
