Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14(A) (2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the “SC/ST Act”) against the refusal of prayer for anticipatory bail vide order dated 30.06.2018 passed by the learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (POCSO) Act, Purnea in Special (POCSO) Case No.61 of 2018, arising out of Kasba Police Station Case No.103 of 2018 registered under Sections 354(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code as well as Section 8/12 of the POCSO Act, 2012 and and Section 3 (i) (xii) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.



The victim has supported the allegation against the appellant to have attempted to ravish her after dragging her into a crop field.

Considering the nature of allegation, I am not inclined to enlarge the appellant, above named, on anticipatory bail. Hence, his prayer against the refusal of prayer for anticipatory bail is refused and accordingly, this appeal stands dismissed.
