ORAL ORDER

3 10-10-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 419/420/120B/467/468/471 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of the Lottery Regulation Act.

Submission is that lottery ticket was recovered from the house of co-accused Raj Kumar Chaudhary and on his confessional statement petitioners' name surfaced during investigation. The petitioners have stated on oath that they have got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid fact, let the



petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Jamalpur Police Station Case No. 169 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
