By way of the present writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a direction to the respondents for quashing the result of election for area no. 19 of Mukhiya in Gram Panchayat Koili Simara (west) which was declared on 01.06.2016.

2. Section 137 of the Bihar Panchayat Raj Act, 2006 provides that the election to any office of a Panchayat or a Gram Katchahry shall not be called in question except by an election petition.



3. In view of availability of an efficacious statutory remedy to the petitioner for redressal of his grievance and the same having not been availed of, I am not inclined to entertain the present writ petition under extra-ordinary writ jurisdiction. Accordingly, it is dismissed.
