**8      30-08-2018**                      No one appears for the petitioner. Counsel for the respondent Corporation is present.

Counsel for the Corporation submits that other than the fact that the petitioner as per the scheme applicable in the Corporation for rehabilitation of the family of the employees is not entitled to benefit of compassionate appointment, the application of the petitioner lacks bonafide since the specific case of the respondents is that the petitioner has misrepresented regarding his marital status.
