The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the notice dated 26.07.2011 issued under the signature of the Certificate Officer, Samastipur in Certificate Case No. 3/2011-12 along with its entire proceedings; and for connected reliefs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits on instruction that the outstanding amount together with interest aggregating to Rs. 1,80,650/- has since already been deposited with the respondent-Board vide receipt dated 19.10.2016 and hence the entire amount of the certificated demand stands satisfied.
