ORAL ORDER

3 17-01-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State. No one appears on behalf of the opposite party no.2.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Fulwari Sharif (Janipur) P.S. Case No.631 of 2016 registered under Sections 341, 323 and 498(A)/34 of the Indian Penal Code besides Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, pending in the court of Smt. Sheema Eram, Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Patna.

Admittedly, the prayer of the petitioner for grant of privilege of pre-arrest bail was rejected by this Court vide order



dated 31.07.2017 passed in Criminal Misc. No.17785 of 2017 on merit.
