This application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of the first information report (for short 'FIR') of Adarsh Jamui P. S. Case No. 175 of 2017 registered *inter alia* under Section 408 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From perusal of the FIR of Adarsh Jamui P. S. Case No. 175 of 2017, as contained in Annexure 1 to the present application, it



would be manifest that the allegations do attract the ingredients of a cognizable offence.

In that view of the matter, I see no illegality in institution of the FIR or its investigation. Accordingly, the application, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
