The present application has been filed for modification of order dated 22-11-2017 passed in CWJC No. 4539 of 2014 by which, the writ petition was disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to prefer an appeal before the State Appellate Authority against the order dated 24-01-2010 passed by the Member, District



Teachers Employment Appellate Authority, Motihari within a period of thirty days from the date of order i.e. 22-11-2017.
