appearing on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition was filed against the decision of District Teachers Employment Appellate Tribunal, Aurangabad, contained in Annexure-1. He submits that now the State Appellate Authority is available against the decision of the District Teachers Employment Appellate Tribunal as Appellate forum and as such petitioners may be granted liberty to approach the State Appellate Authority.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner, in case such appeal is filed by the petitioner within a period of one month from today along with copy of this order, the Appellate Authority will condone the
