The learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that the petitioner be granted a liberty to file an appropriate appeal against the order of punishment dated 26.7.2017 passed by the Electrical Superintending Engineer, Electric Supply Circle, Bhagalpur.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner, I



deem it fit and proper to permit the petitioner to withdraw the present petition with a liberty to file an appeal against the order of punishment within a period of four weeks from today and in case such an appeal is filed, the same shall be disposed of by the appellate authority within a period of six weeks thereafter by a reasoned and speaking order.

The writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
