ORAL ORDER

2 30-03-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 3 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 3 be directed to dispose off the said representation within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner may file a representation regarding his grievances within two weeks and in case such representation is filed before the respondent no. 3, then the same may be considered and disposed off within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the said representation by a



speaking and reasoned order.

If any payment is found due after passing of the final order, the same shall be made within four weeks of passing of the final order.

The writ petition is disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
