Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in Kochas P.S. Case No. 87 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Section-307 & other minor Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged in the written report that these petitioners assaulted the brother of the informant and also caused injury by fire-arms.

The injury report is enclosed with the case diary wherein the doctor has opined that the injury is caused by hard and blunt object and the nature of injury is simple in nature.

It has been submitted that the occurrence has taken place on account of land dispute.

In such circumstances, prayer for anticipatory bail is



allowed and it is ordered that the petitioners named above in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court below within six weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with in Kochas P.S. Case No. 87 of 2017 to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sasaram, Rohtas subject to condition as laid down u/S 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. with further conditions (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason, will liable to cancel bail bond of the petitioners and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
