This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners for quashing of the order dated 15.10.2009 passed by the respondent no.3 by which he has declared the Nathani Charitable Trust to be a public trust.

equally efficacious statutory remedy under Section 28(2)(u) of the Bihar Hindu Religious Trust Act before the competent court of District Judge and in view of the fact that the order has been challenged before this Court after more than eight years, I am not inclined to entertain the present application under extraordinary writ jurisdiction.
