The issue in question i.e. amalgamation of two schools is a policy matter, executive in nature and it is not governed by the statutory provision and therefore, we are not inclined to interfere into the matter exercising our extraordinary jurisdiction in a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution in a Public Interest Litigation. The petitioner may bring the grievance of the petitioner to the notice of respondent no.2 and it would be



open for respondent no.2 to decide the same, on a representation filed by the petitioner, within a reasonable period.

With the aforesaid liberty, this application stands disposed of.
