The present case appears to have been settled amongst the

Case No. 1218 of 2002, corresponding to T.R. No. 1654 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

It is directed that the records be returned back to the concerned court.
