Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned

APP for the State as well as counsel for the informant.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in **Rajaun P.S.**

Case No.488 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Section(s)
147, 149, 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506 Indian Penal
Code.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that there
is case and counter case between the parties. Injuries have been
sustained from both sides. There is land dispute between the
parties.

In the instant case, it is alleged that accused persons
assaulted the informant and other family members with lathi,



Danda, Khanti, Kachiya, etc.

Counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that petitioner no.5 has also filed a case against the informant and others vide Rajoun P.S. Case No.510 of 2017 in which all the persons from the side of the petitioners have sustained injury, which is also grievous in nature.

Injury report of injured from the side of the petitioners have been annexed as Annexure-4 series. Injury report of injured of the instant case has been annexed as Anenxure-3 series.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the event of surrender/arrest of the petitioners, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Rajaun P.S. Case No.488 of 2017**, they shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioners shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date



fixed by the court and their absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will be liable to cancel their bail bonds and (3) if petitioners tamper with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioners.
