Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in Kanti P.S. Case No. 9 of
2017 instituted for the offence under Sections-304B/201 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The petitioner is husband of the deceased.

There is allegation against the petitioner that he used to
torture his wife for demand of dowry. The informant has alleged that
the petitioner went to Sasural on 04-01-2017 and made demand of
motorcycle from the informant and has given threat to the informant of
dire consequences if the demand is not fulfilled. It is alleged that the
informant learnt that his daughter has been done to death in her Sasural
and her dead body has been made to disappear.

In such circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant
anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory



bail of the petitioner stands rejected.

The petitioner is directed to surrender in the court below and seek regular bail which will be considered and disposed of on its own merit in accordance with law without being prejudiced by this order.
