ORAL ORDER

2 19-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Sections 30 (a) (d), 38 and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 276 litres foreign liquor was recovered from an orchard. It is further contended that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner claims that he is having clean antecedent and is in custody since 19.02.2018.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the



satisfaction of the Addl. Sessions Judge 3rd Samastipur-cum-Special judge, Excise Act, Samastipur in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No. 55 of 2018.

Further, if the petitioner, after his release in this case, is again found to be involved in similar nature of case then the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bond.
