ORAL ORDER

2 30-04-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

656.64 litres of foreign liquor is said to have been
recovered from the sugarcane field of Dhananjay Singh which is
said to have been hided there by the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
either with the seized liquor or with the place of recovery. He was
not apprehended on the spot. He has been falsely implicated in the



case at the instance of his enemies due to dirty village politics. Though one more case under Excise Act has been lodged against the petitioner, but he is on bail in the aforesaid case. The petitioner has been languishing in custody since 24.02.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge-II cum Special Judge, Excise Court, Begusarai in connection with Cheriabariyarpur P.S. Case No. 06 of 2018.
