2 10-04-2018 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if he is permitted to file a representation before the respondent no. 2 regarding his grievances mentioned in the writ petition and the respondent no. 2 be directed to dispose of the said representation within a specified time frame.
