Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

Vide order dated 15.11.2017 six weeks' time was granted to the respondents to file counter affidavit, but neither the counter affidavit has been filed nor the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

Mr. Santosh Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representation of the petitioner for consideration of his case for appointment as "Tola Sevak" is pending at the level of District Magistrate, Khagaria (respondent no.3) since 04.08.2016. He submits that this writ application may be disposed of with a direction to District Magistrate, Khagaria to dispose of the representation of the petitioner (Annexure-4) one way or the other.

In view of the fact that no counter affidavit has been



filed by the respondents, the writ application is disposed of with a direction to District Magistrate, Khagaria (respondent no.3) to dispose of the representation of the petitioner by a reasoned and speaking order within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the claim of the petitioner.
