learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for offences punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is contended that, as per allegation, 70.600 litres of country made liquor was recovered from a car which was being boarded by the petitioners. Petitioners claim that they are having clean antecedent and are in custody since 11.02.2018.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the abovenamed petitioners are directed to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten



Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.D.J. II-cum-Special Judge, Nawada in connection with G.O Case No. 78/18.

Further, if the petitioners, after their release in this case, are again found to be involved in similar nature of case then the court concerned would be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of their bail bonds.
