2 04-05-2018 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This is an appeal under Section 14A (2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 against the refusal of prayer for regular bail by the learned 1st Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum- Special Judge, East Champaran, Motihari in Dhaka P.S. Case No. 368 of 2017 registered under Sections 147,149,447,427,323,504/379 of the Indian Pena Code as well as under Section 3 (i)(g), 3 (I) (r) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989.

Allegation against the appellant is general and omnibus for commission of abuse, assault and theft etc.

Considering the nature of allegation, let the appellant, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of



Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with the aforesaid case, subject to the condition that the appellant shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the appellant.

Accordingly, the impugned order is set aside and appeal stands allowed.
