Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 419, 420 of the Indian Penal
Code and Section 10 of the Bihar Examination Conduct Act.

Some other candidates were apprehended on
suspicion that they were impersonating in the examination for
some other candidates. In their statement, name of the petitioner
surfaced.

Considering the nature of allegation, let the
petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail
bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Ram Krishna Nagar Police Station Case No. 100 of 2018, subject to the condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation and trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
