Though the appeal is posted for consideration of the

defects pointed out by the office but on call Mr. Chhote Lal Mishra, learned Counsel for the appellant informs that since this appeal arises from the judgment and order passed by a learned Single Judge in exercise of jurisdiction vested under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, no intra-Court appeal would lie, rather the remedy for the appellant is before the Supreme Court.
