2 21-05-2018 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Kalyanpur PS case no. 222 of 2017 instituted for the offences
punishable under Sections 307, 379, 387 and other sections of
Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is regarding the petitioner and one
other co-accused person having apprehended the informant and
thereafter, had demanded Rs. 1 lac extortion money and upon him
failing to pay the same, the petitioner is said to have assaulted the
informant by butt of his carbine on his left ear resulting in injury
to the informant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
though the informant has received butt injury but the same does
not appear to be grievous in nature and as far as the petitioner
herein is concerned, it cannot be said that the petitioner was
involved in the present case and infact hence he has been falsely



implicated in the present case merely on the basis of suspicion. It is further submitted that though two cases are pending against the petitioner from before but in both the said cases, the petitioner is on bail. It is submitted that the petitioner is ready to be imposed any condition for the purposes of grant of bail. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in custody since 02.03.2018.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the abovenamed petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Kalyanpur PS case no. 222 of 2017.

It is further directed that the petitioner shall mark his presence before the officer-in-charge of the concerned police station at 10 am on every Monday and in case of failure to do so on two consecutive occasions, the present privilege of bail shall stand cancelled automatically.
