APP for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 188, 290, 272 and 273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a) and 30(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

40 litres of country made liquor is said to have been recovered from the Hero Honda splendor motorcycle and the petitioners riding on the said motorcycle were apprehended.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioners. They have no concern with the seized liquor. They have been falsely implicated



in the case at the instance of their enemies by planting aforesaid recovery from their possession. They have no criminal antecedent. They have been languishing in custody since 26.04.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Addl. Sessions Judge cum Excise cum SC/ST, Bhagalpur in connection with N.T.P.C. P.S. Case No. 27 of 2018.
