The present petition has been filed for initiating a contempt proceeding against the opposite parties for willful disobedience of the judgment of this Court dated 17.08.2015 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 5475 of 2015 requiring the authorities to consider the petitioner's case and taking decision at their end.

2. None appears on behalf of the petitioner when the matter is called.

3. A show cause has been filed on behalf of opposite parties, Annexure-B whereof being a demand draft no. 399468 dated 06.03.2018 shows that pursuant to the order of this Court the opposite parties have taken a final decision and payment has been made to the



petitioner which was duly acknowledged on behalf of the petitioner as evident from the endorsement thereon. It is therefore submitted that the order of this Court stands complied.
