The present writ petition has been filed for setting aside the order dated 10.03.2017 along with entire Certificate Case No. 14/2014-15 filed by the District Manager, Bihar State Food Corporation, Jehanabad before the District Certificate officer, Jehanabad for a demand of Rs. 95,63,963/- whereby and whereunder the District Certificate Officer, Jehanabad vide its order dated 10.03.2017 held that the Certificate amount is recoverable from the petitioner; and for connected reliefs.
