2 04-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with R.P.F.
Post Fatuha P.S. Case No. 01 of 2018 registered for the offences
under Sections 3 of the R.P.(U.P.) Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
allegation against this petitioner is that he was found to have
stolen 17 numbers of Battery worth Rs. 26,434/-. The case was
initially registered against unknown. However, the petitioner
was apprehended after the occurrence but at the time of his
arrest nothing was recovered from his possession which could
incriminate the petitioner for commission of offence.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has remained



in custody for more than three months, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the ACJM Railway, Patna Junction in connection with RPF Post Fatuha P.S. Case No. 01/2018.

Bailors shall be the family members of the petitioner.
