2 05-06-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with
Majorganj P.S. Case No. 136 of 2018 for the offence under
Section 30 (a) of Bihar Liquor Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent. He submits that seizure
was not made in accordance with the mandatory requirement of
the Section 100 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. He further
submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this
case because they have refused to satisfy the illegal demands
made by the police. Petitioners are in custody since 19.04.2018.



Considering the fact that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they have remained in Jail for more than one month, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District & Session Judge -II Sitamarhi in connection with Mejarganj P.S. Case No. 136 of 2018.
