3 10-07-2018 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This appeal has been preferred under Sections 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, against refusal of the prayer for anticipatory bail by order dated 13.10.2017 by the learned 1st Additional District and Sessions Judge, Samastipur in connection with Singhiya P.S.Case No. 02 of 2017 after 180 days from the date of impugned order. Hence, it is barred under the proviso of Section 14(A)(3) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

Accordingly, it stands dismissed as not maintainable with liberty to the appellants to renew their prayer for anticipatory bail before the learned court below.
