ORAL ORDER

2 14-08-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner, on his surrender, is in custody since
21.06.2018 in connection with Sirdala P.S. Case No. 204 of 2017
for the offence registered under Sections 323, 341, 307, 504 and
506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
present altercation took place on account of petty dispute and the
petitioner is alleged to have attacked the brother of the informant
with *lathi*. It is further submitted that the injuries purported to
have been inflicted by the petitioner have been found to be simple
in nature on the person of the brother of the informant. Therefore,
the petitioner may be extended the privilege of bail.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of A.C.J.M. – V, Nawada in connection with Sirdala P.S. Case NO. 204 of 2017.
