Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Madhubani (Town) P.S.Case No. 177 of 2018 (CRI Case No. 965
of 2018), registered for offences punishable under Section 376 of
Indian Penal Code.

As per the F.I.R., allegation against the petitioner is
of committing rape continuously upon the informant on the pretext
of marriage.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner has committed no offence rather he has falsely
been implicated in this case in order to pressurize him to marry her



and the victim girl was examined by the Medical Board and found that there is no medical evidence of rape upon the body of the victim girl and the petitioner is in custody since 22.05.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P also.

Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional District Judge, Madhubani in connection with Madhubani (Town) P.S.Case No. 177 of 2018 (CRI Case No. 965 of 2018), subject to the following conditions:-

- i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
