APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 30(a)(d) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

50 Kg of Mahua flower kept in the bag is said to
have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner in the
railway coach.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that no incriminating article has been recovered from the
conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern
with the seized article. He has been falsely implicated in the case



by the personnel of GRP over some altercation on his refusal to cough up the demand of graft made by them. He has no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 07.07.2018.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.D.J.-V cum Special Judge, Excise, Gaya in connection with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 192 of 2018, G.R. No. 304 of 2018.
