Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is custody in connection with Kanti
(Panapur OP) P.S. case no. 143 of 2018 for the offence under
Sections 341, 323, 379, 384 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. She further submits that
the occurrence took place on 25.03.2018 and the F.I.R. was lodged
on 26.03.2018, whereas the F.I.R. reached the Court on
31.03.2018 after five days of the lodging of the F.I.R. She further
submits that inordinate delay in reaching the F.I.R. to the Court
concerned creates doubt about the prosecution version. The
petitioner is in custody since 25.05.2018.



Considering the aforesaid, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each **after 25.11.2018** to the satisfaction of Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, West, Muzaffarpur in connection with Kanti (Pranpur O.P.) P.S. case no. 143 of 2018.
