State.

Petitioner seeks bail in connection with Palasi P.S.

Case No. 142 of 2018, Special (POCSO) Case No. 26 of 2018
registered for the offence punishable under sections 366-A and
372/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8 of the POCSO
Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case
due to love affair. As a matter of fact, the victim girl namely
Bibi Suhana @ Sabuna in her statement under section 164
Cr.P.C. (Annexure-3) has not stated anything against this
petitioner. Moreover, doctor examined the victim girl and found
her age is 18 to 19 years old (Annexure-2). Petitioner has no
criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 05.06.2018.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of 1st Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, Araria in connection with Palasi P.S. Case No. 142 of 2018, Special (POCSO) Case No. 26 of 2018.
