APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 427/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in short, is that the accused persons including the petitioners assaulted the informant and his brother with farsa and garasi, as a result of which they sustained injuries.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the petitioner No.3 has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the



petitioners. It is a case and counter case between the parties. The nature of injury is said to be simple. Hence, no offence under Section 307 of the I.P.C. is made out.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate XII, Gopalganj in connection with Bhorey P.S. case No.119 of 2018 (G.R. No.1594 of 2018), subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
