After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition, so that the appellate authority can be requested to reconsider the quantum of sentence since the petitioner is going to retire on 31.08.2018.

In view of the aforesaid, the present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with a direction to the appellate authority to reconsider the entire matter, without being influenced by the appellate order dated 31.10.2016, taking into account the fact that the petitioner is going to retire on 31.08.2018 and on



account of the punishment order, he would be ineligible for grant of the only promotion which he might otherwise get. In such view of the matter, the appellate authority may consider the matter of the petitioner in a sympathetic manner.
