2 28-09-2018 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned A.P.P. for the State.

The Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Special Case No. 70 of 2018, arising out of Kotwali P.S.Case No.
427 of 2018, registered for offences punishable under Sections 27
of N.D.P.S.Act and 290/354 (d)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per F.I.R. allegation against the petitioner along
with other accused persons, is of recovery of one bottle of FIZZ in
which one pipe of Peetal was inserted with full of Ganja.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and
nothing incriminating article has been recovered from the
possession of the petitioner and he is in custody since 10.07.2018.

Heard learned A.P.P also.



Having heard both sides and in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge/Special Judge, Patna in connection with Special Case No. 70 of 2018, arising out of Kotwali P.S.Case No. 427 of 2018, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court.
- ii) The petitioner will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence.
- iii) It is made clear that if petitioner found involved in any of the like offences, in future, prosecution is free to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.
